About the Program

The Mid-America Christian University Church Match Scholarship Program is a unique way that local churches and MACU partner together to keep Christian higher education affordable to a broad range of students. By providing a Church Match Scholarship, your church can help a member of your congregation earn a Bible-based Christian higher education at Mid-America Christian University. Recipients of the Church Match Scholarship Program are eligible to receive a matching scholarship award of \$1,000 per academic year.

Eligibility Requirements

Students Must:

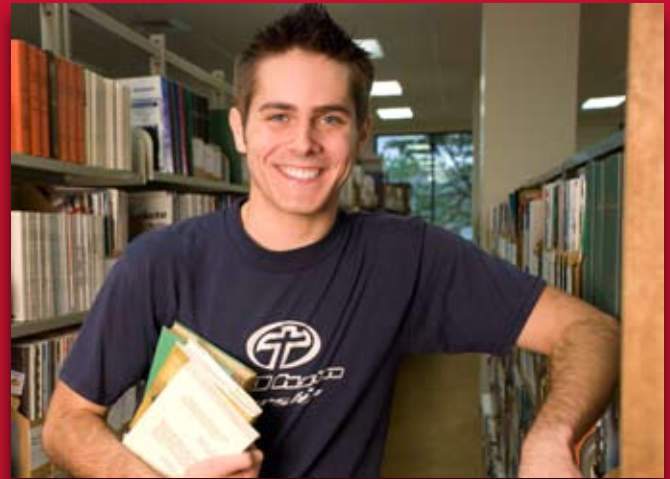
- Maintain full time undergraduate enrollment of 12 credit hours.
- Maintain cumulative GPA of 2.0 (required for subsequent renewal).
- Be in good standing according to University policy.
- Receive Church Match Scholarship from congregation.

The Church Match Scholarship Program is designed to invite financial support from local congregations, not families already responsible for the student. Therefore, gifts must not directly or indirectly originate from persons legally and/or financially responsible for the student or from the student himself/herself. Church contributions are not limited and may originate from multiple churches.* Consider establishing a Scholarship Committee within your local congregation independently responsible for selecting students for scholarship awards and contribution requests.



Important Information

The Church Match Scholarship Program is designed to invite financial support from local congregations, not families already responsible for the student. Therefore, contributions must not directly or indirectly originate from persons legally and/or financially responsible for the student (including parents, siblings, grandparents, uncles or aunts), or from the student himself/herself. Additionally, contributions must not originate from wages a student earned as a result of work performed for the contributing church.

Church contributions are not limited and may originate from multiple churches. However, matching award amounts from MACU will not total more than \$1,000 per academic year.

Contributions must be sent in the form of a check from the contributing church(s). Personal checks are not eligible for the Church Match Scholarship Program. Please write the student's name and "Church Match Scholarship Program" on the memo line of the check and send with a completed scholarship application.

Mid-American Christian University reserves the right to withhold or withdraw the institutional portion of the award if the student has not completed necessary paperwork or fails to meet the eligibility requirements.
