

Listing of Electronic Databases with Descriptions

Receive password information from library circulation desk.

EBSCOhost (includes the 20 databases- much of which is full text)

- **Academic Search Elite**- Provides full text for over 1,530 journals covering the social sciences, humanities, general science, multi-cultural studies, education, and much more.
 - **ATLAS Full Text Plus**- Full text version of the ATLA Religion Database. A collection of over 50 religious and theological journals, and indexing of over 600 journals.
 - **Books in Print with Reviews**- Includes in print, forthcoming, and declared out-of-print or out-of-stock indefinitely as well as full text reviews.
 - **Business Source Elite**- Provides full text for nearly 1,050 journals covering business, management, economics finance, banking, accounting, and more.
 - **Clinical Pharmacology**-Clinical Pharmacology provides up-to-date access, relevant drug monographs for all U.S. prescription drugs, hard-to-find herbal and nutritional supplements, over-the-counter products and new and investigational drugs.
 - **ERIC**- The U.S. Department of Education Educational Resource Information Center database, contains citations and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals, as well as full text of more than 2,200 digests.
 - **EBSCO Animals**- Provides in-depth information on a variety of topics relating to animals. Includes indexing, abstracts, and full text records describing the nature and habitat of familiar animals.
 - **Funk & Wagnall's New World Encyclopedia**- Provides over 25,000 encyclopedic entries. Searchable by subject or keywords within the entry.
 - **Health Source: Consumer Edition**-provides health information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food science and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health.
 - **Health Source: Nursing Academic Edition**- Over 520 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Also featured are abstracts and indexing for over 560 journals.
 - **MAS Ultra**- Provides full text for nearly 460 general interest and current events magazines.
 - **MasterFILE Premier**- Provides full text for nearly 1,880 periodicals covering nearly all subjects including general reference, business, health, and more.
 - **MEDLINE**- Provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and more. Abstracts from over 4,000 current biomedical journals
 - **Middle Search Plus**- Provides full text for nearly 120 magazines covering general topics appropriate for middle and jr. high school students.
 - **Military & Government Collection**-designed to offer current news pertaining to all branches of the military, and has many periodicals and academic journals in full text and abstract form
 - **Newspaper Source**- Provides full text for 139 regional U.S. newspapers, eighteen international newspapers, six newswires, and nine newspaper columns
 - **Primary Search**- Full text for over 50 children's magazines and over 100 children's pamphlets.
 - **Professional Development Collection**- Highly specialized collection of nearly 440 full text journals, designed for professional educators.
 - **PsycINFO**- contains nearly two million citations and summaries of journal articles, book chapters, books and dissertations, all in the field of psychology.
 - **TOPICsearch**-current events database allows researchers explore social, political, and economic issues.

First Search (includes 2 databases)—

- **ECO-Index** of 2,000+ scholarly journals. ; An OCLC collection of scholarly journals
- **WorldCat**-The world's most comprehensive bibliography, with 38 million bibliographic records representing 370 languages and covering information from 4,000 years of knowledge, and holdings information from the world's libraries.

Literature Resource Center – offers literature search, authors on the highway, literary-historical timeline, encyclopedia of literature and gale literary index.

NewsBank—full text news source from over 500 US and Canadian newspapers, news sources, and domestic and international newswires. Also includes 1982-current of Daily Oklahoman and 1989-current of Tulsa World.

Criminal Justice Abstracts—includes only abstracts for the major journals, books, and reports in criminology and related disciplines on topics such as crime trends, prevention projects, corrections, juvenile delinquency, police, courts, offenders, victims, etc.

Christian Periodical Index- indexes periodicals representing the major doctrinal positions within evangelical Christianity including a broad spectrum of knowledge including science, literature, medicine, music, philosophy, history, sociology, nursing, and education.

A Matter of Fact- full text statistical statements on current social, economic, political, health, and environmental issues.

SIRS Discover Deluxe-provides young researchers with a wealth of information from domestic and international magazines, newspapers and government documents. Offering full-text articles and graphics from 1400+ sources on three reading levels

InfoTrac K-12 Edition - user friendly interface that allows searching of magazines, newspapers, and reference books for information on current events, the arts, science, popular culture, health, etc.
