The dorms are furnished with ...

- A twin bed with dresser drawers
- A desk with shelves and a chair
- A closet (55 x 34 x 68) or (39 x 34 x 68)
- Internet connection in each bedroom (students need to provide network cable)
- A window and blinds (35 ¼ x 34 ¼)
- Two couches per dorm
- Cable TV connection in the living room (students need to provide coaxial cable)
 - o Students can run cable to individual rooms; however floor cable must be covered

Did you bring ...

- Twin-sized sheets, bedding, mattress cover, pillows, pillowcases
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Towels
- Cooking/eating utensils
- Dish soap
- Clothes and clothes hangers
- Laundry supplies
- Iron & board
- Snacks
- Fans
- Television/VCR/DVD/radio and alarm clock

Do you know you can bring ...

- Refrigerators that do not exceed 36"
- Microwaves less than 1000 watts
- Coffee pots, hot pots, popcorn poppers, toasters

Do you know you can decorate your dorm room with ...

- Posters (upholding an atmosphere of modesty & holiness)
- Using thumbtacks, straight pins, or sticky tack (limit of 20 tacks)
- Candles if the wicks have been cut, No open flames
- Wallpaper borders using sticky tack or thumb tacks

The following supplies are provided throughout the year ...

- Vacuum (you are welcome to bring your own)
- Cleaning supplies (toilet cleaner, glass & all purpose cleaner; basics only)
- Toilet paper
