- Must be able to work alone or with a team.
- Basic knowledge of minor plumbing, irrigation, heat and air, landscaping is a plus.
- Other duties may be assigned.

Must be able to assist with basic tasks associated with all aspects of facilities maintenance. Must have a positive attitude and be able to work independently as well as part of a group. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Must have a willingness to learn.
