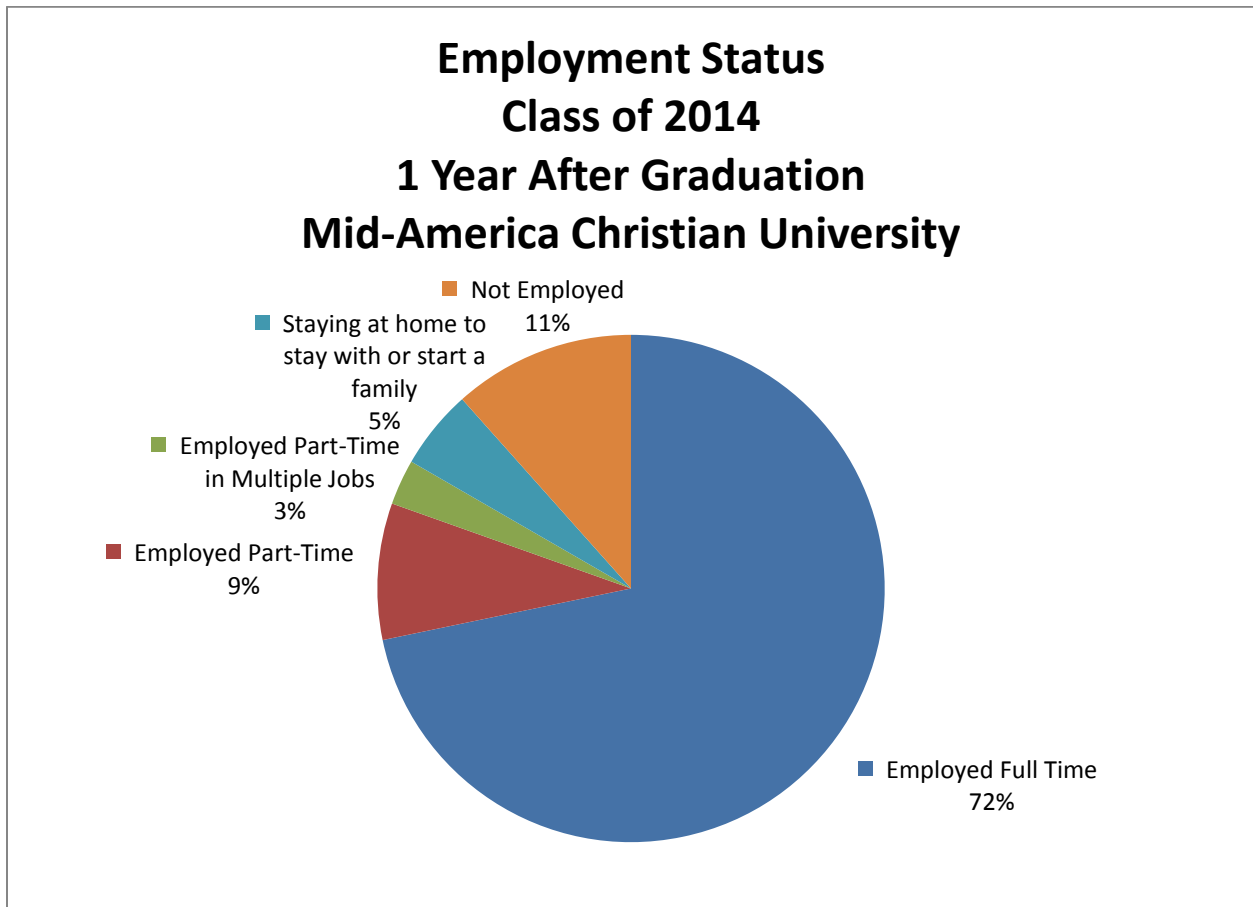

HEA #27 – Placement in Employment

2014 Graduates participated in a Graduate Tracking Survey during the months of April and May 2015 to track their status approximately one year after commencement. The survey was conducted via phone and email.

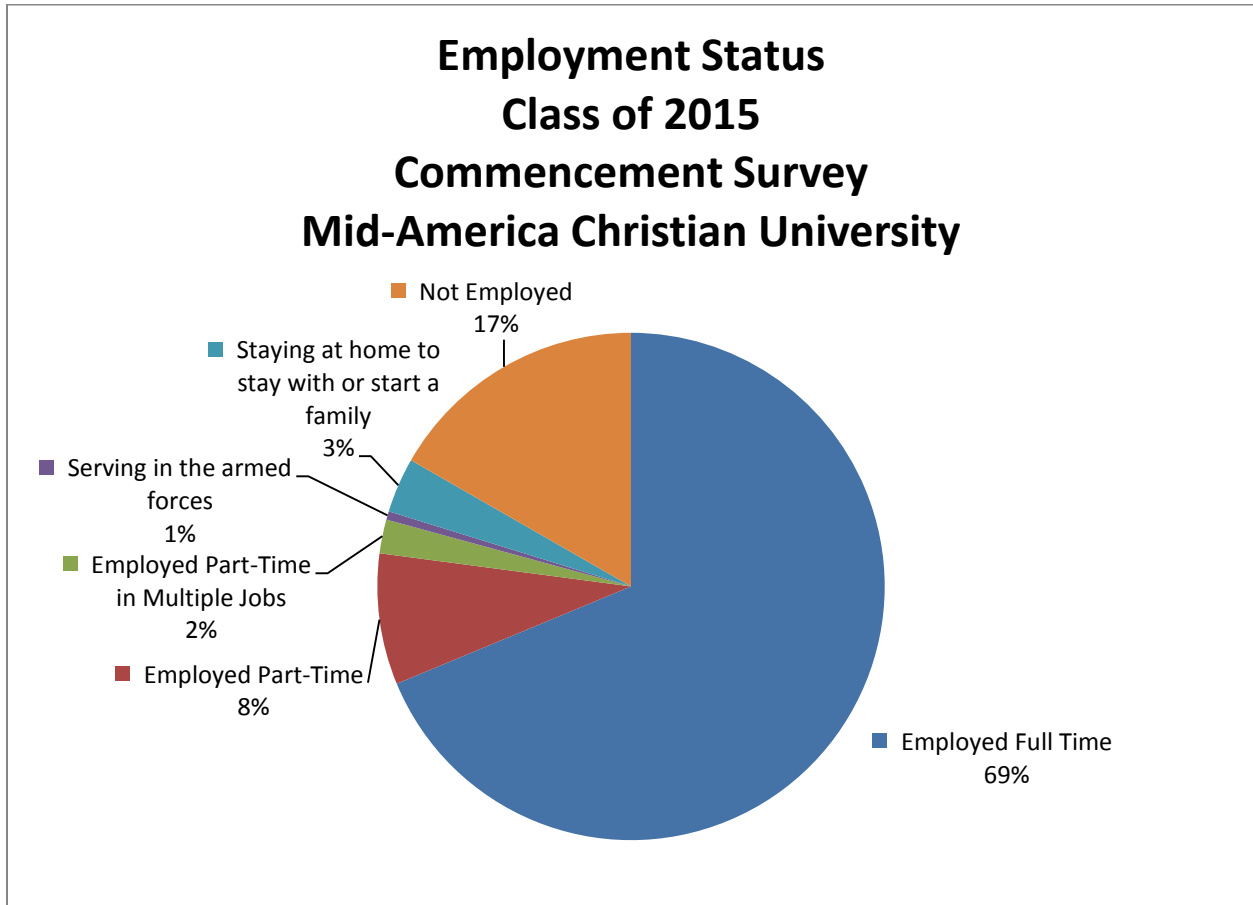
72% of 2014 Graduates who participated in the survey indicated that they were employed full-time approximately one year after graduation.



Placement in Employment & Education of Graduates

May 2015 Graduates participated in the Graduate Tracking Survey in May 2015. The survey was conducted at Commencement on May 2, 2015 and throughout the month of May via email and phone.

71% of the Class of 2015 Graduate Tracking participants indicated that they were employed full-time at the time of the survey. Approximately 1% reported serving in the Armed Forces.



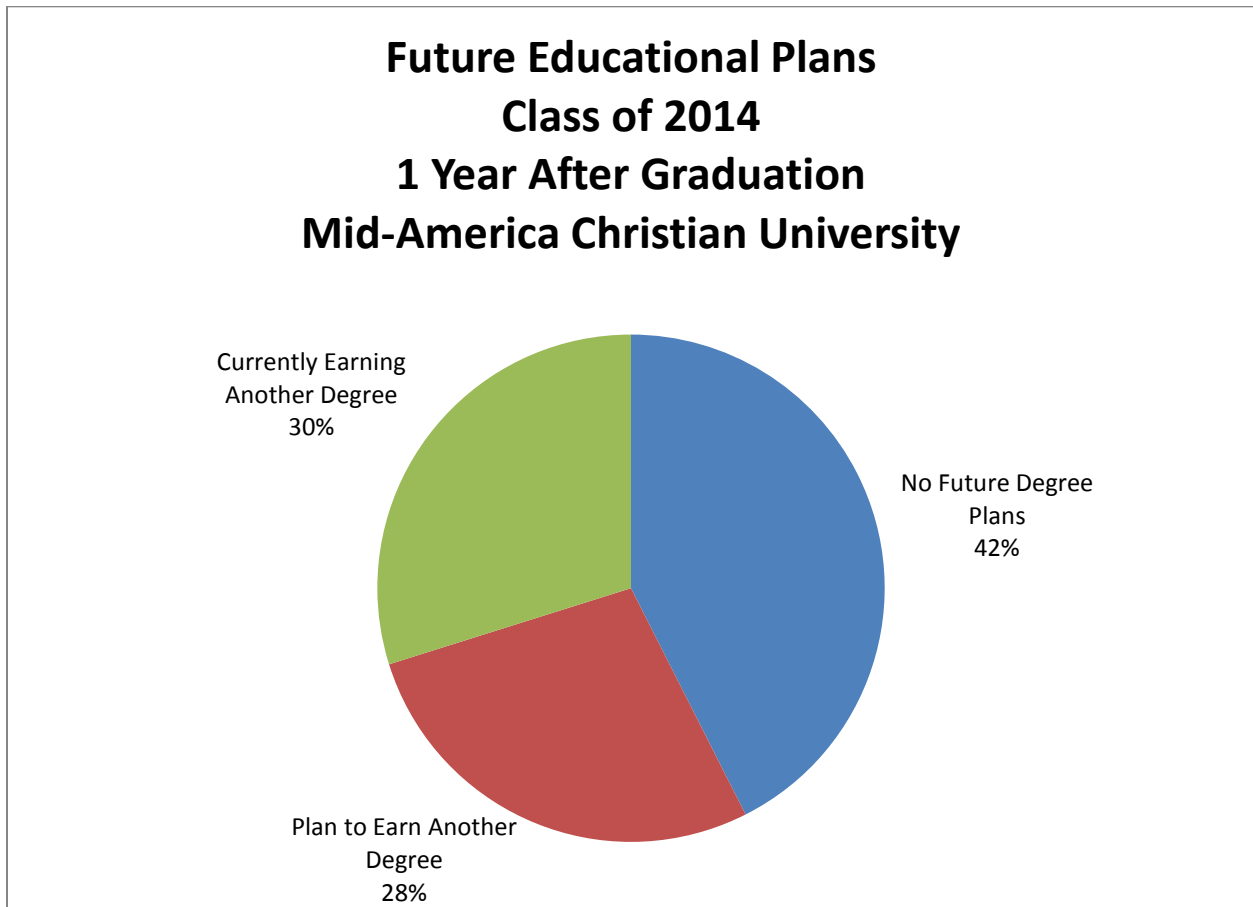
HEA #28 – Job Placement Rates

HEA #29 – Types of Graduate and Professional Education in which the School’s Graduates Enroll

2014 Graduates participated in a Graduate Tracking Survey during the months of April and May 2015 to track their status approximately one year after commencement. The survey was conducted via phone and email.

One year after graduation, 30% of the Class of 2014 survey participants were another degree, including attending seminary; pursuing master’s degrees in areas such as psychology, counseling, business administration, Bible and theology, teaching, public administration, law, social work, and leadership, and pursuing doctoral degrees; another 28% planned to earn another degree at some later point.



Placement in Employment & Education of Graduates

May 2015 Graduates participated in the Graduate Tracking Survey in May 2015. The survey was conducted at Commencement on May 2, 2015 and throughout the month of May via email and phone.

52% of participants indicated that they planned to obtain a Graduate or Professional Degree. 22% indicated that they had completed all of their educational goals.
