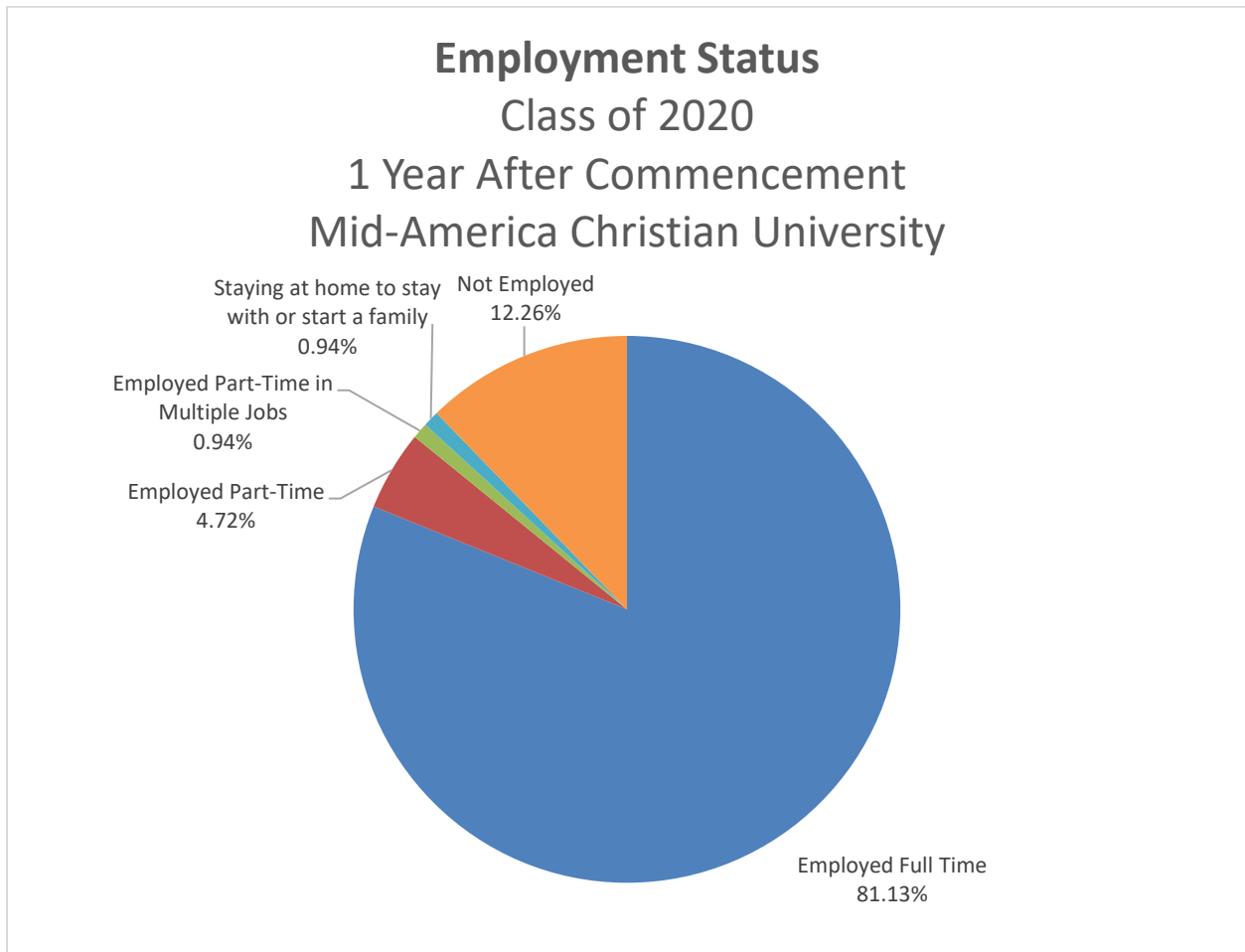

HEA #27 – Placement in Employment

2020 Graduates participated in a Graduate Tracking Survey during the months of April, May, and June 2021 to track their status approximately one year after commencement. Students were contacted via email, text, and phone.

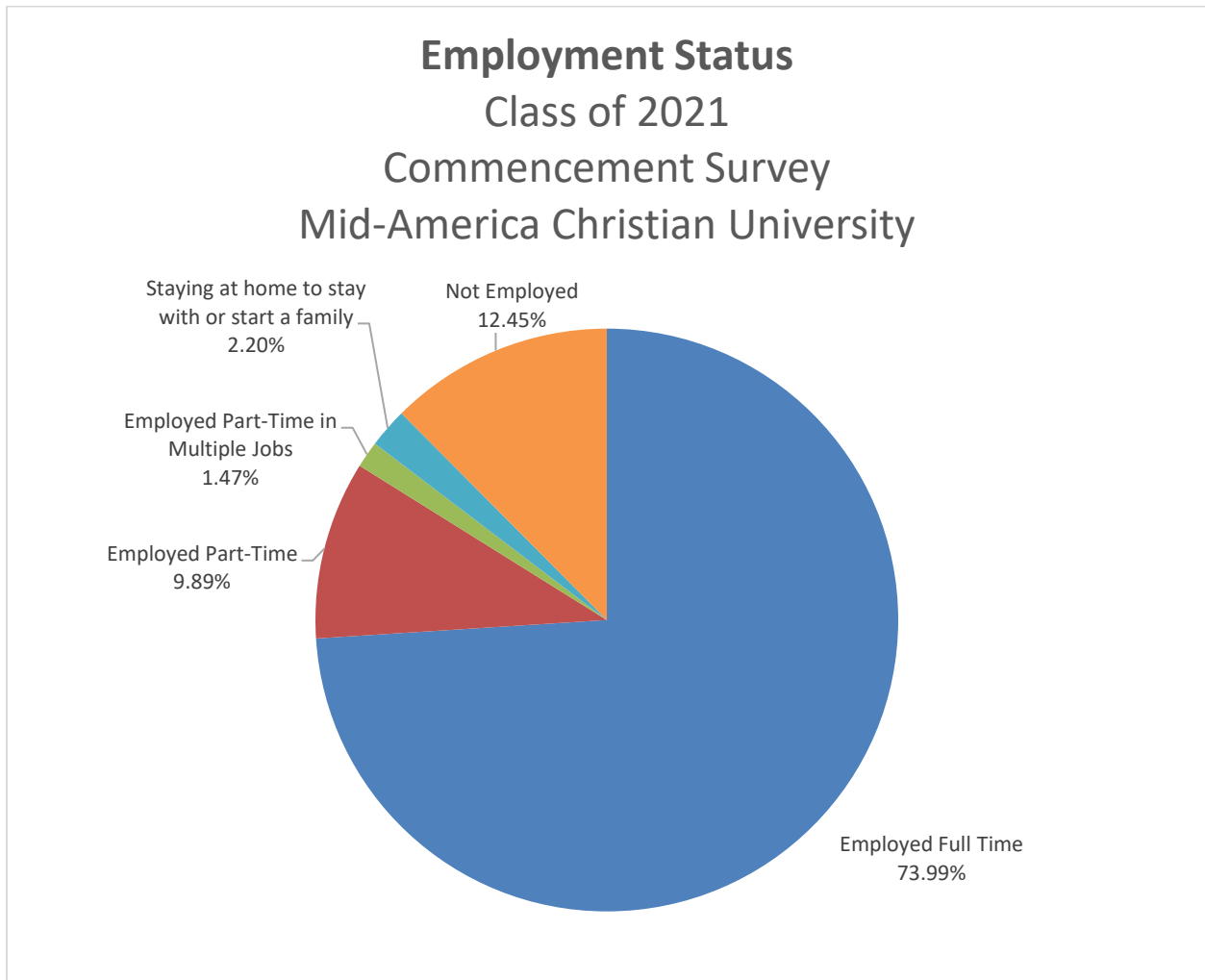
Over 80% of 2020 Graduates who participated in the survey indicated that they were employed full-time approximately one year after graduation.



Placement in Employment & Education of Graduates

The Class of 2021 participated in the Graduate Tracking Survey in May and June 2021. The survey was conducted at Commencement on May 1, 2021 and continued via outreach through email, text, and phone.

Nearly 74% of the respondents from the Class of 2021 indicated that they were employed full-time at the time of the survey.

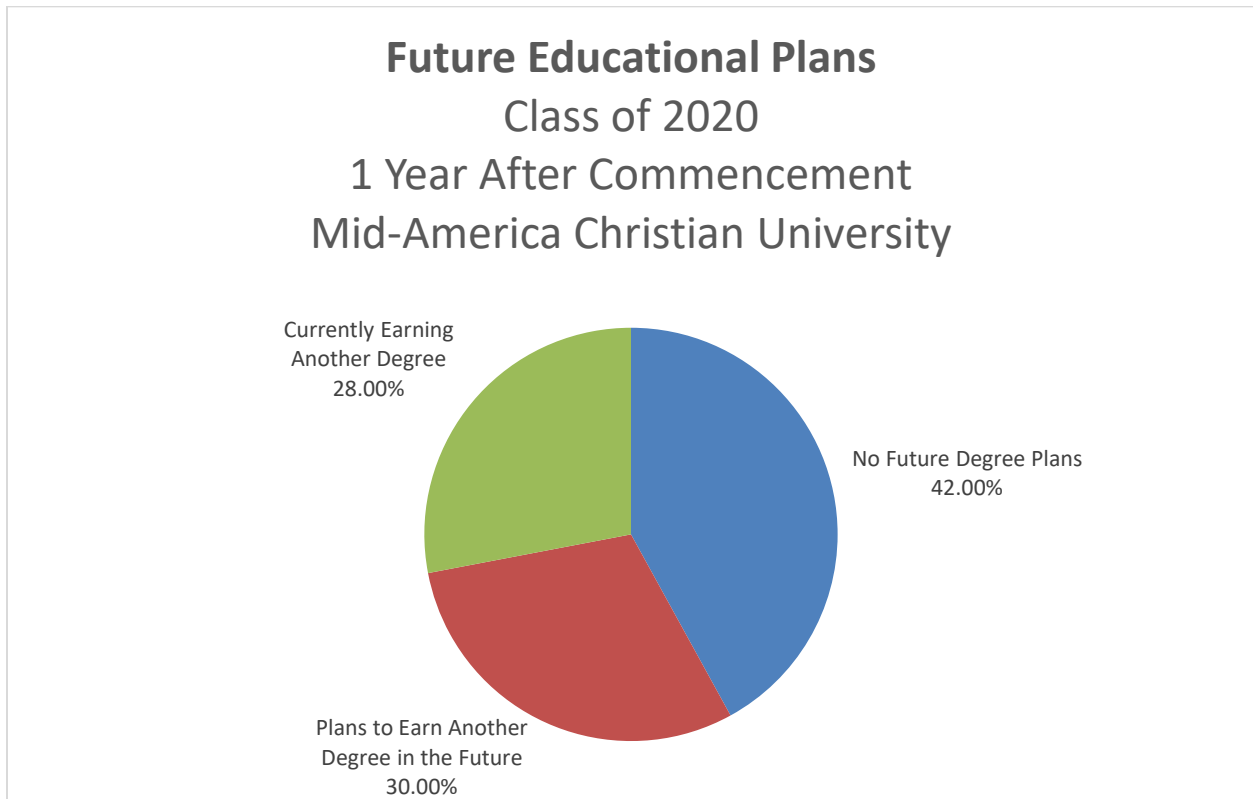
HEA #28 – Job Placement Rates

HEA #29 – Types of Graduate and Professional Education in which the School’s Graduates Enroll

2020 Graduates participated in a Graduate Tracking Survey during the months of April, May, and June 2021 to track their status approximately one year after commencement. Students were contacted via email, text, and phone.

One year after graduation, approximately 28% of the Class of 2020 survey participants were in the process of earning another degree, including attending seminary or pursuing graduate degrees in areas such as psychology, counseling, social work, business administration, Bible and theology, leadership, 30% indicated that they plan to earn another degree at some point in the future.



Placement in Employment & Education of Graduates

The Class of 2021 participated in the Graduate Tracking Survey in May and June 2021. The survey was conducted at Commencement on May 1, 2021 and continued via outreach through email, text, and phone.

Approximately 36% of participants indicated that they planned to obtain a Graduate or Professional Degree. 22% indicated that they had completed all of their educational goals.
