- Obtain the Federal Student Aid ID at studentaid.gov
- Do not share your Department of Education FSA ID with anyone!

- Use your 2019 tax information
- Use your FSA user ID to electronically sign the FAFSA
- studentaid.gov (MACU school code: 006942)

- If you use Federal Student Loans, you must complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN)
- You will also need Loan Entrance Counseling
- studentaid.gov
