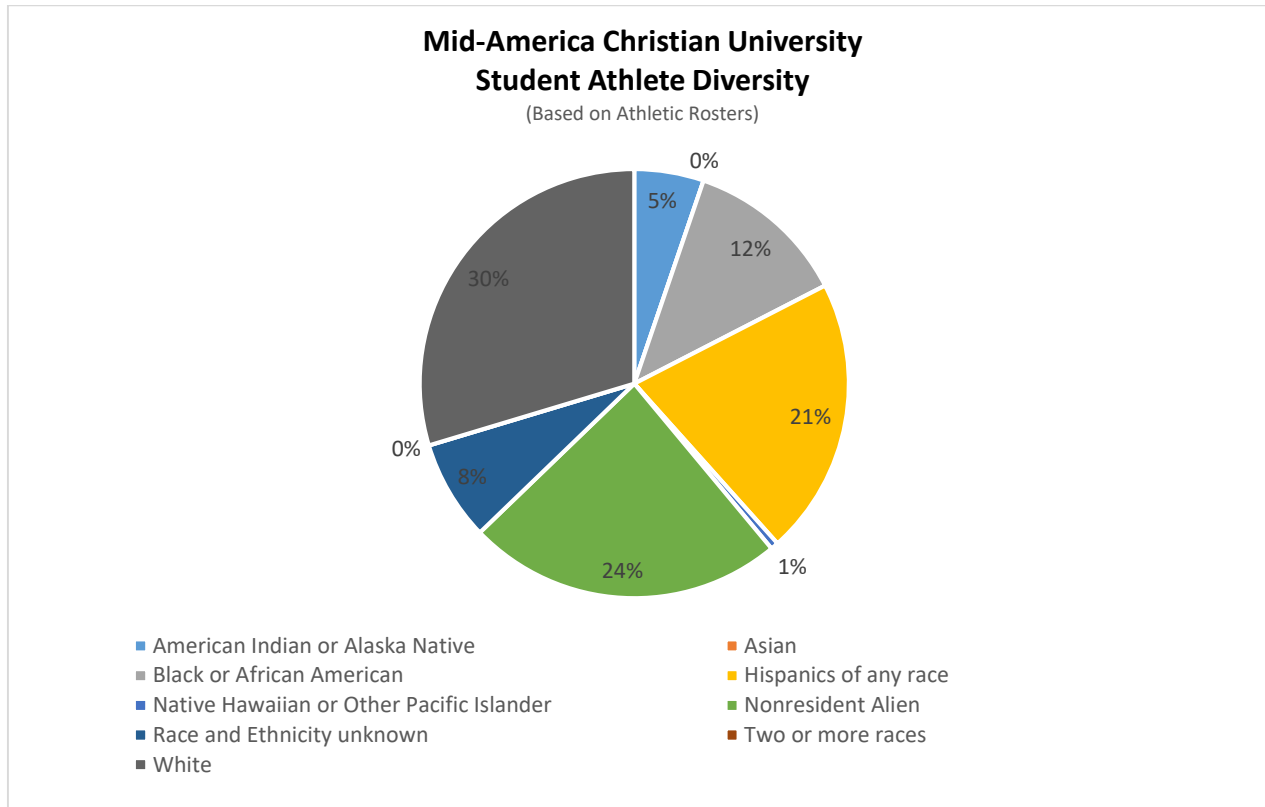

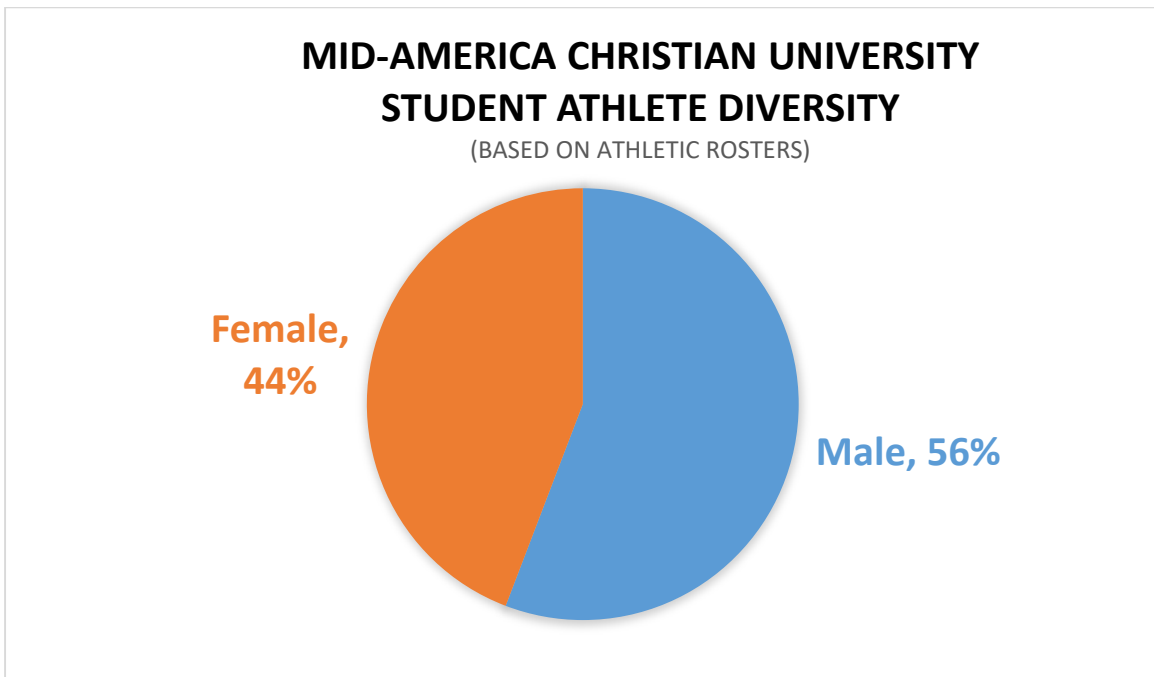

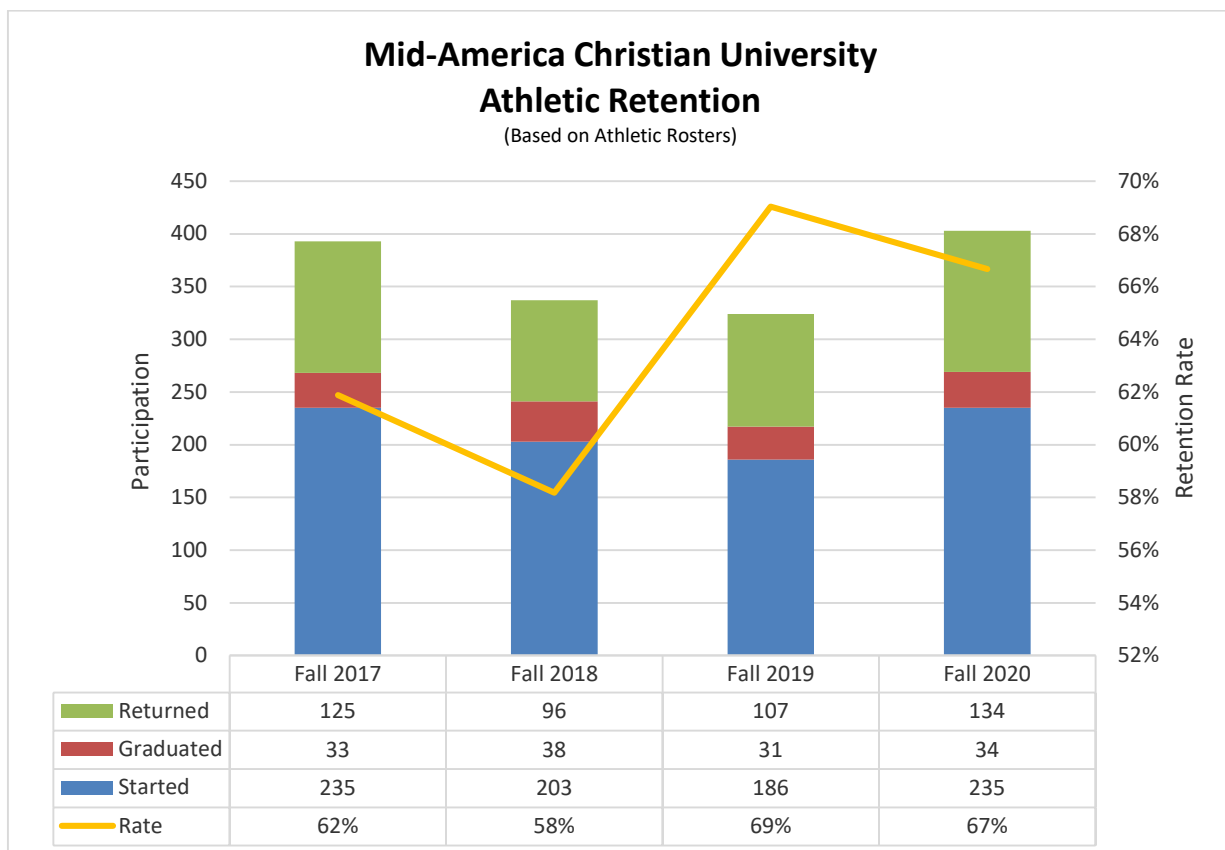

## Retention by Gender

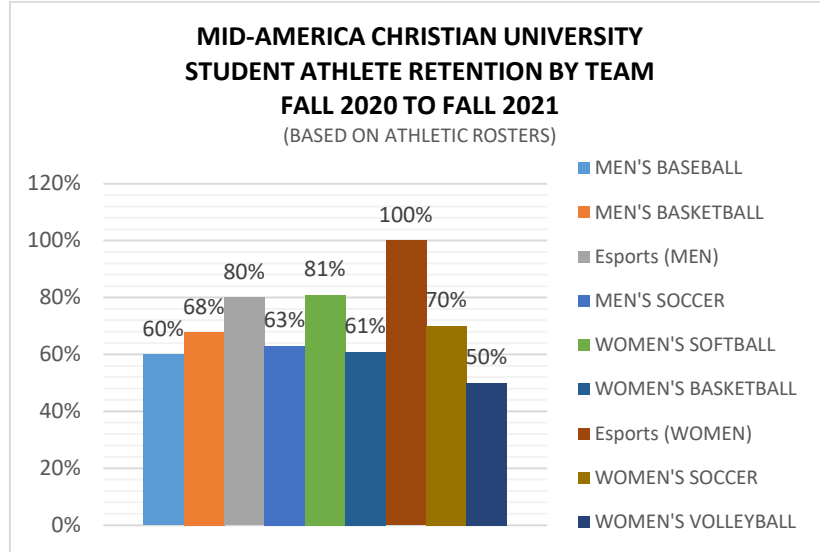
