Steps to Receiving VA Education Benefits

Step 1: Apply for VA Education Benefits

Step 2: Fill Out Your Student Responsibility Agreement

Every MACU student receiving VA education benefits must fill out, update, and provide a copy of the Student Responsibility Agreement (SRA) at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. Please <u>click</u> <u>here</u> to download the SRA.

Step 3: Receive Certification of Your Benefits

Your MACU Student Veteran Advisor will certify your benefits according to your enrollment and billed cost of tuition and required fees. This certification communicates your enrollment and expenses to the VA electronically so they can award your eligible benefits. Please expect a 2-10 week time frame for all benefits to be received

Please note: If you receive Chapter 33, Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits, you are required to verify your enrollment every month of attendance. This can be done either by opting in to receive monthly text messages from the VA OR at by visiting the website by clicking here.

If you receive Chapter 30 or 1606, you must complete a Student Verification of Enrollment on the last day of the month. This can be done through the W.A.V.E. portal or by calling 1-877-823-2378.
