### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

This certificate program will prepare students for employment in an entry-level accounting position or for greater accounting responsibilities at work, prepare them for a more advanced degree in accounting, and satisfy the prerequisite course requirements for students wishing to enter the Master of Business Administration, CPA Accounting Emphasis degree without an undergraduate Accounting degree.

## CAREER OUTLOOK

Employment in business and financial operations occupations is projected to grow 7 percent from 2020 to 2030.

This median annual wage for accountants and auditors was \$73,560 in May 2020, which was higher than the median annual wage for all occupations of \$41,950. Top jobs include:
