

INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS CERTIFICATE

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This 18-hour certificate program exposes students to advanced concepts specific to International Business providing a valuable credential demonstrating graduate-level training in the discipline. The Certificate may be earned as part of a full Master's Degree program, or used at a later date to satisfy many of the requirements of a full graduate degree in the selected discipline.

CAREER OUTLOOK

Employment in business and financial operations occupations is projected to grow 8 percent from 2020 to 2030, adding about 750,800 new jobs.

This median annual wage for business and financial occupations was \$72,250 in May 2020, which was higher than the median annual wage for all occupations of \$41,950.

ACCREDITATION

MACU is accredited through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA).

PROGRAM COSTS

Courses in MACU's International Business certificate program cost \$618/credit hour.
