

MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTING

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This 18-hour certificate program exposes students to advanced concepts specific to Management Accounting providing a valuable credential demonstrating graduate-level training in the discipline. The Certificate may be earned as part of a full Master's Degree program, or used at a later date to satisfy many of the requirements of a full graduate degree in the selected discipline.

PREREQUISITE

A Bachelor's Degree in Accounting or Financial Core Accounting Certificate is a prerequisite for this certificate program.

CAREER OUTLOOK

Employment of accountants and auditors is projected to grow 7 percent from 2020 to 2030.

This median annual wage for accountants and auditors was \$73,560 in May 2020, which was higher than the median annual wage for all occupations of \$41,950.

PROGRAM COSTS

Courses in MACU's Management Accounting certificate program cost \$650/credit hour.

ACCREDITATION

MACU is accredited through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA).
