PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Veterans' Policy Certificate (VPC) is a 24-credit-hour interdisciplinary academic program that focuses on understanding the policies associated with the military veteran population within the United States. VPC graduates will have the basic knowledge needed to work within non-profit, private, or government organizations that support Military Veterans.

CAREER OUTLOOK

According to Military.com, there are more than 7,000 U.S.-based nonprofits helping veterans and military families. Every state has its own Veterans Affairs office, with nearly 9,000 job openings available across the country on usajobs.gov as of April 2022.

ACCREDITATION

MACU is accredited through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA).
