PROGRAM OUTCOMES


Throughout your program, you'll position yourself for success in the accounting field through the extensive study of taxation, auditing, managerial accounting, financial and accounting law and accounting information systems.

The program provides the coursework needed to meet the 30-hour accounting and 9-hour business requirement needed to sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or Certified Management Accountant (CMA) exams in Oklahoma. Students typically need a total of 150 hours to sit, which can be accomplished with a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from MACU.

PROGRAM COSTS

Courses in MACU's Accounting and Ethics program cost \$435/credit hour for lower division (University Core) classes and \$499/hour for upper division (Major) classes.



CAREER OUTLOOK

Employment in business and financial operations occupations is projected to grow 7 percent from 2020 to 2030.
