



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Care and Support Ministry Certificate is a 24-hour certificate that assists students in developing skills that provide care and support for those experiencing mental and behavioral issues. However, it provides foundational courses and knowledge for pastors, volunteers, and nonprofits seeking ways to assist licensed individuals in the care and support of those facing issues dealing with life.

More than ever, people in our churches and communities struggle with mental and behavioral health issues. This can be seen in the rise of care ministries in local churches that provide outreach, support, and recovery groups. This non-counseling certificate program will give the learner a greater awareness and sensitivity to Christ-centered care and support for those experiencing life difficulties. This certificate provides foundational courses for students desiring to pursue degrees in ministry, psychology, or counseling. This certificate does not lead to licensure or meet PEER qualification requirements.
