

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The **Master of Ministry** degree is designed for pastors, lay leaders, and those committed to serving through Christian ministry. It builds a strong foundation in biblical studies, church history, and spiritual formation, while teaching practical leadership, strategic planning, and evangelism skills that can be applied right away. With required practicums, students gain hands-on experience in a church setting, preparing them to mentor, preach, evangelize, and serve in leadership roles within the local church or ministry settings. This degree is focused on practical ministry, not on teaching theology at the university level.

EMPHASIS OPTIONS

Students can choose to pursue an emphasis in one of the following specializations.

- Ministry Leadership (36 hrs.)
- Pastoral Care (36 hrs.)
- Pastoral Studies (48 hrs.)

Your emphasis must be selected before completing the first four core courses to avoid taking unnecessary courses.
