

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

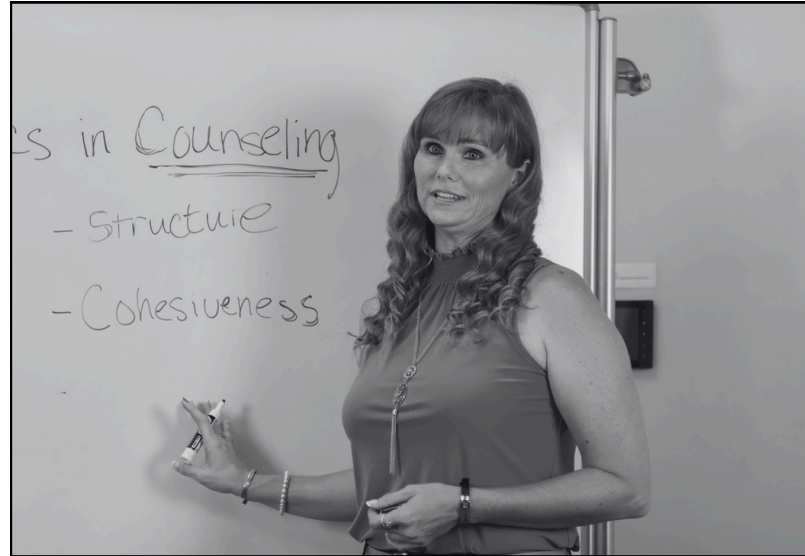

As a result, graduates are equipped to work effectively with students, parents, and other educators in a classroom environment. The Certificate in C&I does not give you teacher certification. Still, it can provide the necessary coursework to meet the requirements needed for alternative teaching credentials in Oklahoma and help you prepare for the Teacher Certification Exams. Prospective students for this program who are pursuing alternative certification should apply to your State Department of Education's website first to determine what your requirements are.
