

CARE AND SUPPORT MINISTRY CERTIFICATE

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Care and Support Ministry Certificate is a 24-hour certificate that assists students in developing skills that provide care and support for those experiencing mental and behavioral issues. This certificate does not lead to licensure nor meets PEER qualifications. However, it provides foundational courses and knowledge for pastors, volunteers, and nonprofits seeking ways to assist licensed individuals in the care and support of those facing issues dealing with life.

PREREQUISITES

- Academic Standing: Sophomore level or higher (25 or more successfully completed college-level credits), or one year of verifiable ministry experience as an alternative pathway.
- Foundational Coursework:
 - ENGL 1113 and ENGL 1213: English Composition I and I
 - COMM 1103: Fundamentals of Public Speaking
 - PMIN 3103: Homiletics I
