## MACU Full Tuition Scholarship Essay Information

If you are a First Time Freshman or a Transfer student who qualifies for the full tuition scholarship, please answer one of the following prompts using the guidelines and rubrics and return to <a href="mailto:admissions@macu.edu">admissions@macu.edu</a>. Transfer students must turn essays in by April 1<sup>st</sup> and First Time Freshmen must turn theirs in by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

To be eligible for the MACU Full Tuition Scholarship, First Time Freshmen have between a 33 ACT (or SAT equivalent) and a 4.0 GPA to a 36 ACT (or SAT equivalent) and a 3.7 GPA. Transfer students must have between a 3.9 to a 4.0 transferring GPA to be eligible to compete for the MACU Full Tuition Scholarship.

<u>Prompt #1</u>: Write a 750 - 1000 word essay that explains your perspective of how the Wesleyan perspective can be used to solve local and/or global problems.

<u>Prompt #2</u>: Write a 750 - 1000 word essay arguing what you believe is the most important and effective "work(s)" a Christian can do for the Glory of God for the good of society. Use the following verse in full or in part in your response.

"Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father." (John 14:12)

<u>Prompt #3</u>: Write a 750 - 1000 word essay explaining your understanding of what it means "to prepare people to do greater things for God and His kingdom."

Your essay needs to be completed in proper MLA format. Refer to the <u>Purdue OWL: MLA General Formatting</u> website for specific MLA formatting tips and explanations. You may also use the Essay Scholarship Template provided for you to ensure your essay is submitted in the proper format.
